

## Standards for Programming

- 1. Programs should fit our definition of a library program as described in the library program policy:** *A library program is a public activity sponsored or co-sponsored by the Library occurring at the Library, at the Digital Branch, on a bookmobile or at offsite locations.*
- 2. Programs should follow all library policies that mention programs.**
- 3. Programs will follow the library's programming guidelines**
- 4. Programs will support the library's mission:** *Your place, stories you want. Information you need. Connections you seek.*
- 5. Programs will support the library's vision,**
  - a) *You know us - and we know you*
  - b) *You trust us*
  - c) *You are proud of us*
  - d) *You inspire us*
  - e) *You can't read enough (for us)!*
- 6. Programs will support the commitment of the library.**  
*Enhance our citizens' lives through convenient services when, where and how they need them.*
- 7. Programs will support the goals of the library.**
  - a) *Support the economic vitality of our community.*
  - b) *Monitor and respond to societal changes with information to help people manage and improve their lives.*
  - c) *Support and nourish the community's spirit, imagination and culture.*
  - d) *Contribute to the growth and development of our community's families and children.*
- 8. Programs will address the needs of (be appropriate for) the intended audience.**
- 9. Programmers will be knowledgeable about the topic of the program.**
- 10. Programs will make a connection to the library's collection or literacy in general.**
